



Statement of Policy

Conflict Area Minerals - Responsible Minerals Initiative

Based on the information provided by our raw material suppliers, Cal-Aurum Industries confirms that to the best of our knowledge, the metals used in our processing tanks and resulting plated deposits do not contain metals originating from conflict areas. More specifically, it is the policy of our suppliers to use responsibly sourced minerals (including gold and tin) supplied by smelters that comply with the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP).

Cal-Aurum is aware of the concerns surrounding the possible use of conflict minerals in the supply chain. It is our policy to ensure to the highest degree possible that our suppliers do not use such materials, metals, or components in the products and services provided to CAI.
